

## TO DEFEAT THE TWO WILMETTE PARK DISTRICT PROPERTY TAX INCREASE REFERENDA TOTALING \$14.5 MILLION

- Shall the bonds of the Wilmette Park District, Cook County, Illinois, to the amount of Twelve Million Seven Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$12,700,000) be issued for the purpose of constructing, equipping and maintaining infrastructure and facilities in Gillson Park?
- Shall the bonds of the Wilmette Park District, Cook County, Illinois, to the amount of One Million Eight Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,800,000) be issued for the purpose of constructing, equipping and maintaining infrastructure and facilities in Langdon Park?
  - ★ Increases your property taxes for unnecessary government structures and government control of 59 acres of pristine lakefront.
  - ★ \$1.3 million for toilets added to your park district property taxes.
  - The \$14,500,000 in total bonds does not include the interest you will be forced to pay in higher property taxes.

80% of local spending is for salaries and benefits of government employees!
